# You may find these useful:

#### Write everything down

Get a diary and write down the date of every contact you have, or try to have, with DCP or any other relevant organisation. Always leave your name and get the name of the person you speak to when you ring DCP.

**QUICK TIPS** 

#### Always appear in court

Every time - even if you're told you don't have to.

## **Obtain legal advice/representation**

please see over for telephone numbers.

#### You can appeal decisions

e.g. Care plans with the Case review panel, legal aid applications

## Check your Court Proposal (S143 Document)

You would have received this when time limited orders were made This will outline the things the department want you to do;

## You have the right to lodge a complaint with DCP

#### Stay visible

Have contact with as many other organisations as possible, so others can speak up for you.

### Get support

Take someone with you to every meeting.
